LAMINATE FLOORS

KNOW-HOW

- The Flooring 1-2-3 book is a great resource for a flooring project
- Always purchase 10% extra flooring planks to allow for scrap
- Store the flooring planks in the room where it will be installed at least 48 hours prior to installation to acclimate the wood to the local humidity
- Make sure the subfloor is clean, free from dust, oil, wax or grease
- The underlayment overlaps should be adhered to create a single protective membrane
- If installing over concrete, check the water vapor emission. It may be necessary to use the 6 mil. Moisture Barricade for addition protection
- To improve appearance, plan your layout with planks running the length of the room
- Use 1/4 In. Installation spacers between the floor perimeter and wall to allow for the proper expansion space
