Homemade Lemon & Lavender Linen Spray

Freshen up your household fabrics with a sweet smelling spray.

I LOVE ESSENTIAL OILS for making homemade air freshener and linen spray. Recently, I've been coming up with all kind of sprays! You can make your own linen spray, too.

TO ELIMINATE any bathroom odors and make towels and sheets smell amazing, try making one of my favorite homemade linen sprays!

It's simple and requires only a few ingredients. You can make this spray with any essential oil fragrances, but I recommend lemon and lavender.



LEMON & LAVENDER LINEN SPRAY

What you'll need:

- ☐ 30 Drops of essential oils
- ☐ 3 oz. rubbing alcohol or Vodka
- ☐ 1.5 cups distilled water
- spray bottle
- ☐ funnel (or mix in a glass measuring cup for easy pouring)

Directions:

- Mix 30 drops of essential oils and 3 oz. of rubbing alcohol or Vodka into a glass. I used 15 drops of lemon oil and 15 drops of lavender oil.
- **2.** Add 1-1/2 cups of distilled water to the mixture.
- 3. Pour into a spray bottle.
- **4.** Shake the bottle before each use.

I recently used this spray on some stinky wicker baskets and the odor went away immediately. Love it!













THINGS YOU'LL NEED

- Wax stripper or heavyduty cleaner
- Grout brush
- Bleaching cleanser
- Water
- Masonry sealer

Grout Cleaning 101

Make a tough job easy and keep your grout looking great from now on.

NO ONE LIKES GRUNGY GROUT IN THE SHOWER OR IN THE BACKSPLASH AROUND THE VANITY. Keep yours clean and fresh with these tips for getting rid of stains and mildew.

old GROUT may need cleaning with a wax stripper or heavy-duty cleaner plus a grout brush. Use a bleaching cleanser on tough spots. Once the grout is as clean as you can get it, rinse it well. When it's thoroughly dry, apply a coat of masonry sealer so that it doesn't absorb dirt in the future. Do not use bleach to clean colored grout.

CLEAN COLORED

GROUT with a heavy-duty cleaner and a grout brush, but don't use bleach as this may remove the color from the grout. Be sure to never use a bleaching solution on colored grout. A masonry sealer can be applied to clean, colored grout to ward off future stains.

FOR MILDEWED

GROUT in tubs or showers, use a grout brush with a 1 to 5 solution of chlorine bleach and water (do not use bleach to clean colored grout.). Never use bleach in combination with any ammonia-based products, and be sure the area is well ventilated before you begin. When you've finished, rinse the area well to remove all traces of bleach.













EASY DISHWASHER TIPS

that will help you save money

DISHWASHER MAINTENANCE IS ESSENTIAL. Cleaning your dishwasher and looking out for early signs of trouble saves you from spending hundreds of dollars on repairs - or even more on a premature replacement. Follow the tips below to keep your dishwasher in top shape - otherwise you might have to hire an appliance repair professional.



Check The Sprayer Arm.

Sometimes the way you load the dishwasher can put utensils or plates in the way of the sprayer arm's rotation. The holes of the arm can also become clogged; use a toothpick or another item to dislodge whatever is stuck.



Check The Drain. Look in the bottom of the dishwasher and remove any food or other clogs from the filter. Then, run the garbage disposal to clear out the drain they share.



Don't Confuse Scraping With Washing. Never throw dishes in the dishwasher with food on them. And don't just rinse them with water either. If there are hard-to-remove food scraps on your dishes, use a utensil to remove them. The dishwasher won't always be able to remove them, and you don't want to clog the drain.



Test The Water. There's a chance that minerals are making your water hard. This includes salts like magnesium chloride and calcium chloride or other ground minerals. It leads to cloudy residue on your dishes and the washer itself. If that's the case, vou should have a softener installed.



Clean The Dishwasher

Trap. In the very bottom of the dishwasher, under the sprayer, is a removable trap that will likely contain pieces of food that didn't make it through to the drain. Sometimes, the tray will come out completely, and sometimes it won't. Clean it out regularly.



Clean The Dishwasher

Seals. Over time, your dishwasher seal (i.e. what keeps the water from getting out during the wash) accumulates debris around the rubber. Clean the rubber gasket with a damp towel so the grime doesn't build up and break the seal.



Clean The Inside Of Your Dishwasher. Inside

your dishwasher, there's the potential for grease, detergent residue and calcium buildup. Use vinegar to wash all of that away. Run a cycle of the dishwasher with vinegar only (no detergent) every few months. It helps to keep the dishwasher clean.



Check The Water Heater's Temperature. Make sure

your water heater is between 120 and 125 degrees Fahrenheit. Otherwise, your dishes are not being washed appropriately. If it's too high, your dishes will not be flash dried and the dirt won't come off.



Don't Overcrowd The

Dishwasher. While you want to fit all of your dishes into the dishwasher, you don't want to block the sprayer arm. Organize it well; maybe compromise and hand wash a few dishes.



Don't Overuse Detergent.

It's not always necessary to fill the detergent cup. Some dishwasher manuals will tell you fill it only one-fourth or one-half of the way. Check your dishwasher's EARN MOP manual.

Taming the Towels





WHETHER YOU HAVE A COUNTRY-KITSCH KITCHEN OR A SLEEK, MODERN LOOK, this DIY towel bar made from black steel pipe and fittings will add a striking touch to the room. Even though you wouldn't think of pipes and fittings looking good along side the antiques or high-gloss cabinets, it really looks pretty cool! And you can find all the supplies at your local Home Depot.

HERE'S WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- ✓ Industrial Towel Bar Supplies
- ½" black pipe (in any length you would like your towel bar to be)
- **2** − ½" 90-degree elbows
- ✓ 2 ½" close nipples
- ✓ 2 ½" floor plates
- 12 1" stainless steel wood screws



STEP 1

• Use two 8-inch pipe wrenches or slip-joint pliers and attach the elbows to the ends of your pipe. Cover the jaws of the pipe wrenches or pliers with a heavy cloth so they don't scratch the pipe and fittings.

STEP 2

 Now thread the close nipples into the elbows, do not tighten at this time.

STEP 3

 Attach the floor plates to the close nipples and tighten by hand only, you don't need to have these connections super tight.

- Make any adjustments to the towel bar to get both floor plates to align up flush on the surface where you will be mounting the bar.
- Apply a protective coating using a clear polyacrylic; this will prevent the pipe and fitting from rusting.
 We used Minwax Clear Semi-Gloss Polycrylic.

MOUNTING

 Mount the bar using the stainless steel wood screws. Be sure to predrill your holes so you don't split the wood.



FAST FIX

This project was quick and easy, in less than an hour, including drying time, the industrial towel bar was up and ready to use.

DIY Menu Board

Hey mom, what's for dinner?

OH HOW MANY TIMES I've heard this from my family over the years. I've been on the lookout for the perfect way to answer that question. After much thought, I came up with the perfect DIY Menu Board.

I wanted the board to be awesome so it combines functionality and good looks. While I love the look of chalkboard, I didn't necessarily want the mess of all the chalk dust. My creative solution ... cover it with clear acrylic plexiglass and use a white chalk marker or neon dryerase markers.

This also makes it easy to clean. I used wall decals to add beautiful

lettering. I received the lettering and size I wanted for the project, and I couldn't be happier! Now it's time to get to work putting together this awesome project.

SUPPLIES

- Clear Acrylic Sheet 0.100 x 24 x 48 (this can be found at The Home Depot)
- Black Chalkboard 24 x 48 (this can also be found at The Home Depot)
- 24 x 48 Picture Frame (we made our own)
- Decorative masking tape
- · White China Markers
- · Custom wall decals

TOOLS

- 1 FrogTape
- Tape Measure
- String
- Clear Packing Tape

- Once you have everything it's time to mark out the chalkboard. This takes the most time but it is worth it.
- Start with the 1 FrogTape, run a strip around the perimeter of the chalkboard, then add an additional strip at the top.
- Working from the top left hand corner mark 3 1/4 in from the left. Repeat at the bottom. Then again start at the top left hand corner and mark the left edge at 8, 14, 20, 26, 32, 38 and 44. Repeat along the right hand edge.

Then take the clear tape and string and connect the marks. This gives you a grid to align the wall decals. Finish by marking the top center.

Now we get to make the menu board look awesome.

Work from the top down starting with the menu decal. Read the directions provided by the manufacturer and important preparation tips for a foolproof application.

- ✓ Next, find the center of the menu decal, align the mark with the top center mark on the board. Remove the backing paper and align the marks. Smooth out the decal using the provided squeegee.
- ☑ Carefully and slowly peel off the transfer paper. Then run a piece of decorative masking tape across the top.
- ✓ Now let's move on to the other decals, this is where you'll be glad you spent the time marking and making the string grid. Follow the same basic steps you did to apply the menu decal but use the strings to align them to keep them straight and true. Align the top and bottom dots with the vertical string and the left and right dots with the horizontal string.
- Once all the wall decals are on you can remove the tape and string.
- Now we assemble the Menu Board, a quick 1-2-3. Place the acrylic glass in the frame, then the finished chalkboard. Use window-glazing points to keep them in the frame. Now it's time to put it to work!







Kitchen Storage
